

# The Minnesota Out-of-School Time Partnership



The Minnesota Out-of-School Time Partnership is a network of public and private organizations dedicated to the

belief that all Minnesota communities must ensure options for children and youth to learn, develop, and contribute during non-school hours.

## history

The Out-of-School Time Partnership

was created in 2001 when an advisory group to the Minnesota Department of Education (MDE) recognized a need to increase public awareness about out-of-school time activities for youth (ages 5-18) and ensure that communities throughout the state had quality programs and services available to families and their children. This dedicated group of people and organizations laid the groundwork for this new organization.

## goals

- ◆ Increase public awareness and support for out-of-school time opportunities for children and youth.
- ◆ Ensure that all children and youth have access to sustainable, quality out-of-school time programs and activities.
- ◆ Create and sustain an integrated, statewide capacity-building system to increase the effectiveness and impact of out-of-school time programs.

## today

The Partnership has grown in

membership and activity, expanding from a group of about a dozen members to thirty-three entities representing statewide advocacy membership groups, state agencies, field support and program provider organizations, universities and colleges, as well as funders and foundations.

Success has meant transitioning from an informal collaborative to a fund-raising, work-plan driven partnership with clear goals and a strategy for the future. These successes include:

- The establishment of four working groups targeted to field support, communications, policy and partnership management.
- A joint partnership with the University of Minnesota to sponsor the first ever Commission on Out-of-School Time Report (report is available at [www.mncost.org](http://www.mncost.org))
- FrameWorks communications research

Even now, the Partnership is moving deliberately forward to establish a statewide organizational infrastructure to build on the work done to date.
